Endoscopic Basic Course – 2 days

Endoscopic spinal surgery – Endoscopic treatments of the lumbosacral spine

- > Transforaminal endoscopic access (TESSYS®)
- > Interlaminar endoscopic access (iLESSYS® Pro)
- > Endoscopic facet joint and sacroiliac joint treatment (MultiZYTE®)

Description

Day one is focused on the endoscopic transforaminal access to the spinal canal for the treatment of lumbar disc herniations. On the second day, the focus lies on the extension of knowledge of the transforaminal access as well as on the interlaminar access specifically at L5/S1. Additionally, endoscopic facet and sacroiliac joint treatment will be trained.

Endoscopic Advanced Course – 2 days

Endoscopic spinal surgery of the lumbar and cervical spine

- > Transforaminal endoscopic access for stenosis (TESSYS®)
- > Interlaminar endoscopic access (iLESSYS® Pro and Delta; lumbar and cervical)
- > Cervical endoscopic decompression (CESSYS® Ventral and Dorsal)
- > Transforaminal endoscopic stabilization (EndoLIF® cages)
- > Percutaneous stabilization techniques (Percusys®)

Description

Day one focuses on the endoscopic transforaminal and interlaminar access to the spinal canal for lumbar decompression with various systems: TESSYS®, iLESSYS® Pro, iLESSYS® Delta. On the second day, the interlaminar access with iLESSYS® Delta for lumbar decompression as well as CESSYS® Dorsal for cervical decompression is shown. The ventral cervical transdiscal access with CESSYS® Ventral is trained on a sawbone model. Optionally, stabilization techniques are shown.

Description

This one-day course has been set up for spine surgeons with experience in endoscopic spinal surgery. Transforaminal and interlaminar techniques can be improved and the range of indications be increased. Stabilization techniques with EndoLIF® and Percusys® are trained as well.

Pain Therapy Course – 1 day

Endoscopic minimally invasive techniques for pain therapy

- > Endoscopic facet joint treatment (MultiZYTE®)
- > Endoscopic sacroiliac joint treatment (MultiZYTE® SI)
- > Endoscopic peripheral nerve treatment (MultiZYTE® PPT)
- > Interventional endoscopic nucleus therapy (intENTS® Lumbar and Cervical)

Description

The main focus of the training course lies on the endoscopic treatment of facet and sacroiliac joint for lower back pain. In addition, endoscopic peripheral nerve treatment (MultiZYTE® PPT) and an intradiscal approach for decompression and the treatment of dorsal annulus fissures (intENTS® Lumbar and Cervical) are shown.

Target group for all courses

Physicians from different disciplines experienced in spinal therapy, interested to learn the latest endoscopic minimally invasive spinal surgery techniques of the complete spinal column. Please understand that course participants must meet preliminary criteria.
